1. Overview of SEAAIR 2016 conference

SEAAIR 2016 conference is the annual conference of the South East Asia Association of Institutional Research (SEAAIR). It is a forum for Higher Education Leaders (HEI), researchers and practitioners to debate regional higher education issues and challenges, and to discuss collaborative solutions. SEAAIR 2016 also promotes the integration of universities in the region and the world's higher education systems through SEAAIR's network.

Rationale of the conference theme

It is almost a universal claim by HEIs around the world that their Visions and Missions are founded on Teaching, Research and Community Service. Claims of excellence in these vary from HEI to HEI and in total they are still feeble. The reason is simply the lack of commitments to this trilogy of honor. It is therefore high time for Higher Education practitioners to throw this into the ring of discussions. One measure of such commitments is engagement defined simply as meaningful interfaces between all stakeholders in each of the trilogy pursuits.

A key questions is "Has the HEI fully explored or exploited their true engagements with society or communities to bring about more successful and conscientious engagements?"

This Conference therefore is pioneering such imperative and as such is aimed at looking or re-looking the engagements of the academics, the HEIs with the students, the stakeholders, the society and the communities from both the social and academic engagements aspects. In turn it will act as a catalyst for an even more significant development in Higher Education.

The theme of SEAAIR 2016 is "Academic and Social Engagements in Higher Education". It includes the following six sub-themes:

- 1. Executing Teaching and Learning Engagements
- 2. Institutionalizing Academic and Social Engagements
- 3. Empowering Technologies for Academic and Social Engagements
- 4. Discovering Institutional Research in Examining Academic and Social Engagements
- 5. Augmenting Quality Practices to Ensure Academic and Social Engagements
- 6. Enhancing Social Engagement Through Service Learning
